Visit the ships that call Lunenburg home: three-masted barque Picton Castle, and iconic Bluenose II, Nova Scotia's sailing ambassador (bluenose.novascotia.ca).

Take in the numerous sights and sounds on this working waterfront, from wooden schooners being built at the Dory Shop, and vessels under repair to fresh seafood catches unloaded at the wharves.


